This meeting with the Mayor and full Council of the Town of Milford for the purpose of presenting tow cost of operation proposals, and to determine if the Town of M lford would be desir us of being connectadg with the disposal. The Board of Trustees offered to install the sewer line connecting the Town of Milford with the disposal plant at the cost of the district. The Town Of Milford w//h/ to pay for the cost of the one lift station which was estimated by Mr Mullinex to be approximately \$15.000.00

The Milford Council was in favor of the cost of operation proposal whereby the 2 mill property tax would be spread for a period of two years, and the estimated yearly budget operating cost of \$35.000.00 be prorated among the 4 Towns as Mr Mullenix outlined. They deferred making a decision on installing the lift station at their wpxpense.

Motion by W W Bean to adjourn, seconded by F K Thomas, carried.
